The Roll Nos. (Organisation-wise and Centre-wise) allotted to the candidates for MTS to Clerk Grade Examination scheduled to be held on 17th October, 2016 are uploaded on the website. The same may be downloaded for further necessary action at your end. No hard copy will be sent separately.

2. Due to administrative reasons it has been decided by the Competent Authority to conduct the examination at 12 centres only. Accordingly, in some case, the nearest centres opted by the candidates have undergone changes and they have been placed to the next nearest centres. As per rule candidates of the changed centres are eligible for Travelling Allowance. However, the candidates who have opted for appearing in the centre other than nearest to their duty station at their own request/recommended by PCsDA/CsDA would not be entitled for Travelling Allowance. PCsDA/CsDA are requested to provide accommodation for outstation candidates if available on request. Change of centre other than already earmarked will not be allowed except under exceptional circumstances.

3. Necessary information may be sent to those centres as well as to the concerned PCsDA/CsDA well in advance in respect to those candidates, who may be appearing from centres other than those falling under your jurisdiction, since any delay in this issue, will adversely affect the prospective candidates.
