**Subject: Holding of the 10<sup>th</sup> All India DAD Cricket Tournament (Men & Women) at PCDA (SC) Pune from 9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> December 2019.**

It has been decided by the Competent Authority that 10<sup>th</sup> All India DAD Cricket Tournament (Men & Women) will be organised by PCDA (SC), Pune under the aegis of DASCBC from 9<sup>th</sup> to 13<sup>th</sup> December 2019.

2. Further, the tournament will be played amongst the qualified 08 teams in Men Category as per details below:

**Men Category:**

- i) Winner team of the 9<sup>th</sup> AIDAD Cricket tournament (Direct entry)
- ii) Runner-up team of the 9<sup>th</sup> AIDAD Cricket tournament (Direct entry)
- iii) One team consisting of only IDAS officers from all over India (Direct entry)
- iv) One teams each from five regions of DASCBC viz. Northern, Southern, Eastern, Western and Central.

3. It has, therefore, been decided by the Competent Authority that the addressee Pr. Controllers/Controller offices will conduct the Zonal round latest by 27<sup>th</sup> November 2019 and confirm the participation of winners teams of Zonal Round (Men) latest by 28<sup>th</sup> November 2019 to the organisers of final round i.e. PCDA (SC) Pune for further action at their end under intimation to this HQrs office. A list of offices in the jurisdiction of each region is enclosed as Annexure 'A' to this letter.

4. Further it is added that all the correspondence with the respective Pr. Controllers/Controllers of their zone/region regarding holding up of the zonal rounds may be made at your end under intimation to this HQrs office.

5. Competent Authority has also approved the budget of Rs. 50,000/- (Fifty Thousand only) each to organize the above zonal tournament.

6. Rules and Regulation for conducting zonal tournament are enclosed where with as Annexure 'B'.

## Annexure 'B'

1. All the matches of the tournament will be played in T-20 format as per rules of BCCI.
2. The tournament would be conducted on League basis by dividing, the participating teams in groups. All the teams in a group to play with each other and top two teams from each group will qualify for semi finals.
3. Winner of one group will play with runner of second group and vice versa and Winner of both groups will play final match.
4. Each team can send maximum of 15 players.
5. One (01) manager may be allowed to accompany the teams to manage the logistics etc. of the teams.
6. The decision of the Umpire nominated by the Nodal Officer will be final.
7. Playing kits/equipments & wearing kits are to be provided by the respective PCDA/CDA Offices.
8. The players will be treated as on duty to participate in tournaments.
