Minutes of the 20th Meeting of DASCB

The Board met at 11.00 A.M. on Thursday, the 23rd February, 2017 in HQrs. Office, Delhi and the following were present.

At the outset, Secretary DASCB welcomed the Chair and all members of the Board and opening remarks were delivered by the Addl. CGDA & Vice Chairperson DASCB. Further Secretary DASCB gave a presentation on DASCB activities for the last financial year.

- 2. Minutes of the 19th Meeting of DASCB held on 24.02.2016 were confirmed and action taken points were taken up for discussion.
 - (i) Action taken Point No. 3(i, ii & iii):
 - Secretary DASCB informed that various Sports Federations/ Boards were contacted for affiliations. However, federations/ Boards advised DASCB that the teams may be constituted first and process the case for affiliation subsequently.

- Cricket (Men): PCDA New Delhi informed that 30 players for Cricket (Men) have been finally identified and selected for Coaching Camp and Selection Camp will be organized in due course. It was also intimated that two teams will be formed for coaching camp and subsequent formation of Cricket team.
- Cricket (Women): Nine players in the category have been identified by the PCDA (SC). PCDA (SC) has requested DASCB to provide names of Cricket Sports quota recruits (Women), which would be provided.
- (ii) Action Taken Point No. 3(iv): Broad procedure and guidelines on recruitment of Sports Quota personnel:
 - Secretary DASCB informed that process of recruitment of 150 Sports personnel has been initiated.
- (iii) Action Taken Point No. 3(v &vi): Proposal to increase annual grant to DASCB and matter of giving 15% quantitative discount to DASCB instead of Army Sports Development Fund.
 - (a) Secretary DASCB intimated that additional grant is required for DASCB to conduct tournaments in this year and arrangements for necessary kits/ training to the players. Chairman directed DASCB to take up the matter with MOD. The proposal is under consideration.
 - (b) Chairman DASCB was of the view that quantitative discount should not be given to Army Sports Development Fund and matter may be taken with MOD/QMG if the orders on the same are issued by Government of India/Ministry of Defence. In this regard, it was decided that directions may be issued to Controllers for depositing the 15% of quantitative discounts direct to DASCB account as a resource generation activity for funding activities under DASCB.
 - (c) It was agreed that there should not be any issue regarding accruing and acceptance of donations, sponsorships from PSUs. However, to receive funds from private bodies, it was decided that a committee comprising of the following officers was constituted. The committee will explore the pros and cons of raising

funds from private organizations as well as from individual monthly contributions from officers and staff of the service e.g. @ Rs. 10/- per month from officers and Rs. 04/- per month from staff and will submit it's report within two months to the Chairperson DASCB.

(d) Action Point No. 3(xii): Posting of Sports Quota personnel to their choice place of posting:

- Sr. Dy.CGDA(AN) made a presentation on draft transfer policy. The draft transfer policy of sports personnel was discussed. It was proposed that consultation of DASCB may be obtained for transfer of Sports quota recruits and also other sportsmen of National level and above. Accordingly, transfer policy for sports quota personnel will be formulated by Administration Section of the CGDA HQrs. Office.
- DASCB will monitor the performance of all sports quota entrants at quarterly intervals.

3. Agenda Points were discussed and the following decisions were arrived at:

(a) Sports Calendar for the year 2017-18 finalized as under:

- Regular meditation/Yoga classes in morning/evening or during the weekends for healthy living may be held at field level.
- Trekking/Mountaineering for DAD personnel was approved during the discussion and will be organized centrally by DASCB.
- (b) Introduction of Zonal level tournaments instead of All India Tournaments for better participation of DAD fraternity.
 - In this regard Chairman has directed to PCDA (P) Allahabad to conduct Volley Ball tournaments at local level with Railways, Services, and State Government etc.
- (C) Discussion on Sports Quota recruits transfer policy:
 - Same as stated vide action taken point No. (iii) (c) above.
- (c) Providing of Sports Kits to Sports person representing DASCB.
 - Chairman directed that Sports Kits may be provided to Sports quota persons participating in National level Tournaments by DASCB.
 - Sports Kits for players participating in local level/ AIDAD tournaments may be provided by the Controllers concerned.
- (d) Cash Award /honorarium to outstanding players.
 - The point was discussed & dropped.
- (e) Selection of one best Sports person for Raksha Mantri Award for Excellence.
 - Discussed & dropped.
