## Subject: Bio-metric Attendance System (BAS) for punctuality in defence Estts

All India Association of Civilian Security Officers has addressed a letter to enforce of AADHAR-Enabled Bio-metric Attendance System (AEBAS) for observance of punctuality in defence installations. The Association has stated that in the large defence installations under DGOS, DGEME, E-In-C, DGQA & MES in the lower formations of Indian Army where large strength of defence civilians are employed, the marking of attendance is still done manually. Due to lack of transparency, there is a lot of scope of manipulation in manual attendance system. Also, these defence installations due to holding of sensitive/sophisticated stores are very susceptible to security hazards. It is very challenging job for security officers to ensure proper security of information & security of personnel in these installations. It is imperative to keep check on the long absence of such personnel, but in present mahual system, the long absence cannot be detected easily & quickly.

- It is brought to the notice that the Deptt of Personnel & Training has already 2. issued instructions for installation of Bio-metric devices to monitor punctuality of the staff digitally. These instructions are applicable to all the Central Govt offices. As such, all the Administrative Divisions of MoD are requested to download these instructions of DoPT and issue directions to the field Organisations/Defence Establishments under their control to enforce Bio-metric Attendance system (BAS) in accordance with these instructions in order to ensure punctuality in various Defence Establishments/ field offices through AEBAS.
- A compliance report on the same may please be sought and furnished to the 3. CP Divn. by 30 June 2016.
