Deal Coenetacy,

This has reference to Prime Minister's interaction with Secretaries to Government of India on 2nd April, 2022.

- 2. The Prime Minister, inter-alia, emphasized the following:
 - i. Important issues should be addressed through 'Whole of the Government' approach. Meaningful consultation with all stakeholders should be undertaken. Tendency of working in silos should be eschewed.
 - ii. The ongoing Vision@2047 exercise needs to be completed in a time bound manner. Consultations in this regard should involve all levels of officers including young officers working in the field and at District level.
 - iii. Government to act as a facilitator and act as a catalytic agent for economic development. It is imperative to hand hold the private sector to give impetus to manufacturing and job creation and help Indian companies become world leaders.
 - iv. Employment generation should be given high priority and should be the focus of Government interventions across public and private sectors. Every Ministry/ Department should immediately take steps to fill up existing vacancies against sanctioned posts.
 - v. Decriminalization of minor offences and violations to be taken up on Mission mode. All such provisions need to be reviewed and action taken accordingly to repeal/amend these provisions, in a time bound manner.
 - vi. Skill upgradation and training must be a continuous process. In this regard, full potential of Capacity Building Commission should be utilised for training and capacity building of officers.
 - vii. Global Indices should be regarded as opportunities to benchmark ourselves against best practices, identify shortcomings in our framework and processes, and undertake necessary improvements.

viii. The importance of fiscal discipline at the states' level needs to be suitably communicated. In this regard, the long term fiscal implications of policy measures/decisions should be analysed and shared with State Governments.

ix. Concerted and coordinated actions should be taken by all Ministries in their respective domains under the "Vibrant Border Village" initiative announced in the Budget. Officers may be deputed to such villages for on the ground assessment of challenges and to give a practical prescription for all-round development and mainstreaming of these villages. NCC Schools in the nearest Block/ Cluster/ District should give priority to students from such villages in admission.

x. Long-term opportunities for exports to be assessed by each sector and policies fine-tuned to fully leverage such opportunities.

xi. Cutting edge global technologies in different sectors may be studied in detail and steps taken to adopt them in India.

xii. Proposals submitted to the Cabinet/ Cabinet Committees relating to various projects, schemes, programmes and policies should incorporate benchmarking with global standards with respect to that proposal.

xiii. It is important that the Policy formulation is based on field visits and practical assessment of the situation on ground. Officers to be motivated to go for field visits to understand grassroot problems and find practical solutions.

xiv. Under Azaadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav, an initiative may be launched to build 75 water bodies in every District under MGNREGA by 15th August, 2022.

xv. Action to be taken to expeditiously implement recommendations relating to rationalisation of autonomous bodies. Efforts may continue by all Ministries/Departments to identify more such bodies.

xvi. The feasibility of granting composite regulatory clearances based on masterplan for projects identified under Gati Shakti may be explored.

3. I would request you to initiate immediate action based on the aforesaid directions of the Prime Minister.
