

Sir,

I am directed to say that in supersession of the provisions of this Ministry's letter No.20028/DGAFMS/DG-3A/2509/D(Med) dated the 6th July, 1984, as amended vide Corringa No:20028/DGAFMS/DG-3A/4015/D(Med) dated the 12th October, 1984; 20028/DGAFMS/DG-3A/4990/D(Med) dated the 27th December, 1984; and 20028/DGAFMS/DG-3A/1837/D(Med) dated the 1st May, 1985 and letter No.20028/DGAFMS/DG-3A/2605/D(Med) dated the 3rd July, 1985, the President is pleased to decide that for the purpose of authorising the undermentioned types of specialised treatment to the Service personnel and their families, the hospitals noted against them will be recognised as 'Civil Hospitals':-

4. The terms and conditions and the rates for Coronary Bypass Surgery and allied investigations thereto at the hospitals listed at No.(x),(xi),(xii) & (xiii) above will be the same as approved by the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare for CGHS Beneficiaries.

(b) Kidney transplantation

(i) Post Graduate Institute of Medical Education & Research, Chandigarh.

(ii) A.I.I.M.S. New Delhi.

(iii) Christian Medical College, Vellore (Tamil Nadu).

(iv) Jaslok Hospital & Medical Research Centre, Bombay.

(v) The Apollo Hospital, Madras.

2. Accordingly, in partial modification of para 203 of RMSAF-62, ~~service personnel requiring~~ above mentioned treatment for which requisite facilities are not available from service sources may be transferred for treatment at one of the above mentioned hospitals as in-patient on the authority of Dir Gen of Med Services concerned on entitled patients. Ex-post-facto sanction, will however, be obtained in serious cases if immediate treatment is required as a life saving measure, where it may not be possible to obtain prior approval of the DGMS concerned.

3. ~~Families of Services personnel including officers and other~~ ~~above mentioned treatment will also be eligible for treatment~~ in the above mentioned hospitals only as a life saving measures under the provision of this letter. They should in the first instance, report to the local Military Hospitals. The Military Hospital authorities will transfer those patients to the above mentioned hospitals as emergency cases, if considered necessary by them. Families of officers will be transferred to those hospitals at their own expense.

4. The bills for treatment in these hospitals will be paid by the Controller of Defence Accounts concerned after these have been verified and countersigned by the Director Gen of Med Services concerned. Necessary action for making recoveries of hospital stoppages from the officers, JCOs and ORs and their equivalents in the Navy and Air Force and their families will be taken in accordance with para 55(ii) of Financial Regulations(India) Part II read with para 203 and para 5,7 & 30 of Appendix-5 of RMSAF-1962. Recoveries from families of JCOs and ORs and their equivalents in the Navy & Air Force will be as for the head of the family.

5. Further administrative instructions, if any, will be issued by you.

6. Regulations for the Medical Services of the Armed Forces-62 will be amended in due course.

7. The provisions of this letter will be operative upto 31 Mar, 1988 or till facilities for such treatment are established in service hospitals, whichever is earlier.

8. This issues with the concurrence of the Ministry of Defence (Finance) vide their u.o. No.689-PD of 1988.
