PROCEDURE FOR EXPENDITURE ON SPORTS EQUIPMENT / INFRASTRUCTURE / ACTIVITIES

Sir,

- 1. I am directed to convey the sanction of the President for incurring expenditure under Major Head 2078, Minor Head 800 and Code Head 795/01 of Defence Services Estimates Air Force, not exceeding yearly budgetary Sports allocations procurement of Kit on & Gear, Equipment, Infrastructure, Sports Medicine Equipment, Equipment / Machinery required for maintenance of Sports venue / arenas and other sports related expenditure in accordance with Schedule XVI(E) of Air HQ/ 95378/1/Fin P/ 2431/US(RC)/Air-II/06 dated 14 Jul 06 as amended vide Air HQ/95378/1/Fin P/ 56/SO (BB)/Air-IV/09 dated 24 Feb 09 and as amended from time to time.
- 2. The expenditure will be incurred by Air Force authorities under the broad heads and for the purposes as indicated below:-

(a) Procurement of Sports Equipment and Establishment of Sports Facilities

(i) The powers can be used on the Procurement of sports equipment, sports kit and gear, Gym equipment, Fitness equipment, rehabilitation / recovery equipment, training aids, trophies, medals, certificates, sports related infrastructure and all expenditure for procurement / installation / maintenance (including AMC) of sports related equipment required for training, competitions, testing / monitoring of performance, conditioning, rehabilitation, recovery, medicines (including consumables), etc., for all sports disciplines which is officially introduced by SSCB/ AFSCB from time to time.

- (II) Provisioning for laying of Synthetic / wooden surfaces / fields / tracks / courts, etc., for all sports disciplines including indoor surfaces, provisioning of lighting, flood lighting, seating for official, referee, player and any other additional facilities wherever applicable at Air Force team nodal centres / Command team nodal centres and any other unit of Air Force including development and upgradation of sporting fields / courts, with concurrence of IFA and approval of CFA.
- (iii) For sports infrastructure and high value equipment, Priority Procurement Plan will be approved as per Scale of Accommodation /SAI norms. In case Scales/ norms have not been prescribed, or the requirement is beyond prescribed scales/norms, AFSCB may issue guidelines in consultation with Pr. IFA.
- (iv) For development of sports infrastructure, a rep of MES would be included as a technical member of Board of officers responsible for QR preparation, TEC and acceptance of work. At Air Force Stations where MES does not exist, rep of CPWD may be co-opted as technical member for the same.
- (v) An indicative list of sports equipment is placed at appendix to be used as a general guideline.

(b) **Expenditure on Coaching, Training and Competition**

- (i) Consumables and spares for sports equipments, necessary modification / repairs to sport equipments including arms and armament, electronic targets, electronic score board, scoring machines, etc. by local as well as foreign vendors.
- (ii) Hiring of coaches including foreign coaches where necessary due to non availability of qualified Indian Coaches for training of selected players, Sports Nutrition specialist (including the cost of diet supplement) and physiotherapists for training of Air Force teams either at Air Force nodal centres or at their respective training facilities.
- (iii) Hiring of specialised sports arenas and surfaces like Astroturf, hiring of accommodations for training camps of Air Force teams, visiting teams / competitions and sports complexes / ranges, etc.,
- (iv) Expenditure on photography, videography, print, media coverage, PA system, audio visual equipment, display devices, advertisements, etc.

- (v) Hiring of Transport for sporting events and for conveying sportsmen, visiting teams and coaches to sports arena and back where the same is not available through service sources. Conveyance of coaches and officials including foreign nationals for recee of route for marathon, cross country, cycling, etc.
- (vi) Affiliation, membership, participation, entry fees payable to various Sports federation for participation in selection trials, national and International sporting events. Government sanction would invariably be sought for visits abroad.
- (vii) All contingencies and emergent training / administrative requirements (including consumables, fuels, oils, lubricants, etc.) related to sports activities, seminars / workshops, conferences, etc.

(c) Expenditure on Kitting, Extra Diet and Incentives

- (i) Provision / Expenditure on Kitting and Extra Diet to sportsmen, support staff during training / coaching including provision of refreshment and supplements to sports personnel as per policy of AFSCB.
- (ii) Expenses for freight/ import of sports equipment, kit gear, etc. where required.
- (iii) Payment of incentives to sports persons and support staff based on their performance in various competitions.

Note: Sports authority of India (SAI) norms will be used for various items viz. scales of diet etc for sports persons, consumables, kits etc.

(d) <u>Expenditure on Sports Science Equipment and Sports Library</u>

- (i) Accessories and software required for sports science centres for sportsmen including physiology evaluation, nutritional evaluations, biomechanics, biochemistry, basic lab, physiotherapy, rehabilitation, medical inspection, medical aid / treatment, research, dope testing, etc., Expenditure will also include consultancy, analysis, testing of samples, chemical examinations, investigations, repairs, upgradation, replacement of equipment, medical consumables and AMC.
- (ii) Maintenance / Establishment of sports library including publications, books, magazines, electronic storage devices, digital hardware / software, etc.

3. Other Misc Provisions

The Sports Kit and Gear are issued to sportsmen as part of personal kitting. However, items of permanent nature like sports equipment, infrastructure, etc., met out of SAG grant would be the responsibility of the Unit / Station / Nodal Centre.

4. Procedure for Expenditure

- (a) The expenditure in connection with sports activities will be incurred by Air Force Sports Control Board (AFSCB) / Command Sports Control Boards (CSCB) / Air Force Units. AFSCB will sub-allocate the funds to CSCBs based on the requirement.
- (b) AFSCB will act as indenter at AIR HQs level to initiate case file through penultimate CFA to PIFA and CFA for centralised procurement of sports kit & gear / other associated services and facilities as listed above. Similarly, the Command Sports Control Board/ Nodal centres / Air Force Units would initiate cases at Command / Nodal centre / Unit level for approval of respective CFA with concurrence of their IFA. The accounting and disposal of all permanent and consumable spares will be as per the laid down procedures.
- (c) As per the requirement received from Command Sports Control Board the requirement of funds would be projected to D Fin P by AFSCB at the beginning of the year. D Fin P on receipt of requirement would allocate the projected funds to AFSCB.
- (d) The record and cash accounts for the funds allotted under code head 795/01 are to be maintained by 412 AF Station for expenditures incurred by AFSCB. AFSCB sub allocates the funds under code head 795/01 to Command Sports Control Boards / Nodal centres / Air Force Units and the record & cash account for the same are to be maintained by respective accounts sections. A register for expenditure is to be maintained as per AFO 54/77 at AFND accounts section / Command accounts section / Nodal Centre accounts section / Air Force Unit Accounts Section. After ascertaining availability of funds, sufficient funds are to be retained for centralised purchase of sports kit and gear.
- 5. The procurement/ establishment of sports equipment / infrastructure will be done as per the financial powers delegated for this purpose and the procedures laid down in DPM 2009 as amended from time to time.

- 6. On termination of sports activity, all stores procured from Sports Activity Grant and have been issued to the teams, items other than personal kit and under garments will be taken over on charge by unit / formation /sports nodes. The accounting and disposal of all permanent and consumable stores will be as per laid down procedures for stores procured out of Govt. funds. Losses if any, occurring during the sports activity are to be regularised with the approval of CFA as per delegation of financial powers.
- 7. For procurement of any other sports item/equipment/gear required for training and conduct mentioned at the end of each group of items in the indicative list, approval of AFSCB and concurrence of Pr.IFA (AF) would be obtained.
- 8. This issues with the concurrence of Ministry of Defence (Finance/P&W) vide their RF No 507/AF/P&W dated 14 Nov 14.
